Sunday School Offering - Mosquito Nets for India

For the spring semester, the Sunday School students will be partnering with the Luke Society to purchase mosquito nets for families in India. Many people in India suffer from malaria which is carried by mosquitoes. One method to prevent the spread of malaria is to use mosquito nets. Rev. Prem and Dr. Pushpa from the Luke Society give out nets to poor villagers and instruct them on how to use them and on how to improve their surroundings to prevent malaria. This makes a huge difference to the health of these poor families. If they can prevent malaria and the costs of treating malaria, they remain healthier and have more money to spend on food instead of malaria treatments.

As a Sunday School, we want to see how many individuals we can bless with the gift of a mosquito net. One mosquito net cost roughly \$6, and each year the Luke Society tries to hand out over 300 nets in India. *How many nets can we help them purchase?*?
